RULES

MANIPULATION

Printed and Digital Images may be manipulated, as the author feels appropriate. Images entered must be entirely the work of the photographer. Composite Images are permitted provided all component images meet this requirement. For the avoidance of doubt, use of images from any other source including, but not limited to, royalty free image banks, textures and clipart is not permitted.

PRINTS

Printed images should be fixed to a mount with a backing card and held firmly in place with mounting tape. Mounts should be no larger than 500x400mm (20x16ins), whilst prints should be no smaller than A5-210x148mm (8.2x5.8ins).

Each print should have an appropriate title on the back of the mount in the top left corner. The competitor's name should not be written on the mount. Prints should be submitted along with an associated projected digital image sent by e-mail to **bpscomps@gmail.com** or uploaded via the website.

PROJECTED DIGITAL IMAGES (PDIs)

All PDIs should be submitted as jpeg email attachments of no more than 1600 x 1200 pixels, together with details of the competitor's name and the title of the image to the Competition Secretary. Landscape images should not exceed 1600 px on the horizontal edge, whilst portrait images should not exceed 1200 px on the vertical edge.

COMPETITIONS

ANNUAL IMAGE COMPETITION

The competition will be assessed in three groups - Divisions 1, 2 and 3. Judges will be made aware of the division at which each image should be judged and will be asked to award marks accordingly. Each member is invited to submit a maximum of two **Projected Digital Images** (PDIs), or **Mounted Prints** and associated PDIs, for each of the four rounds. **Those in Division 3 are only required to submit Projected Digital Images for all four rounds.** The highest mark scored in each round will count towards the member's overall score. There will be a separate trophy for each division.

MINI PANEL

Each member is invited to submit **six related images as individual PDIs** on a subject of their own choice. These will be arranged into a panel by the competition secretary for assessment by the judge.

MAIN PROJECT

Each member is invited to submit 12 PDIs including a title image, on a theme of their choice.

MONO & COLOUR PRINTS OF THE YEAR

Each member is invited to submit up to **three mounted prints** in total - made up of either two colour and one monochrome, or vice versa, together with associated PDIs, on any subjects taken since 1st January 2019. A Monochrome Image may have single colour toning but any additional colours are not permitted.

SUBMISSION

For prints, a box will be placed at the back of the hall on submission nights, and all PDIs must be emailed by the deadline to the competition secretary at **bpscomps@gmail.com** or uploaded via the form on the website.
